


CANDLE SAFETY GUIDE

Follow these simple steps for a safer and more enjoyable experience.



A candle creates a unique atmosphere and fills the interior with fragrance, but remember that it is, above all, a source of open fire. To enjoy it completely safely, please follow these rules:



Place the candle on a flat and heat-resistant surface.



Keep the candle out of reach of children and pets.



Never leave a burning candle unattended.



Avoid burning candles in areas exposed to drafts and wind.



Do not inhale smoke or vapors directly above the flame.



Use stable and heat-resistant coasters.




Keep away from other heat sources and sunny areas.



Do not move the candle while burning.



Never extinguish a candle with water or by blowing it out. Use a cover dedicated to extinguishing candles.



Regularly trim the wick to a length of 0.5-1 cm before each lighting of the candle.




Do not drop any materials into a burning candle.



The candle should only be burned in an upright position.



Do not burn the candle to the end. Leave at least 1 cm of wax at the bottom.



Keep at least 10 cm of space between lit candles.
